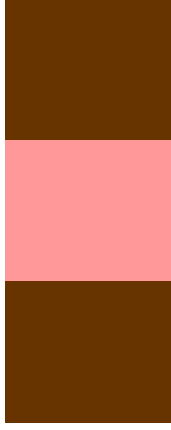

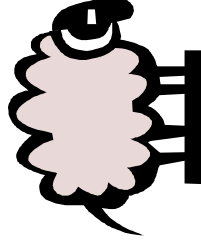


# Project Night Night

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## Our Mission



Project Night Night is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt charitable organization that provides "Night Night" packages of blankets, books, and stuffed animals to children in shelters.

We believe that every child deserves a good night's sleep. Children in shelters often leave home without cherished objects such as security blankets and that favorite stuffed animal, thereby making the transition to shelter housing all the more difficult and traumatic for them.

On the whole, shelters are noisy, crowded, and frightening. It is our hope that after receiving the Night Night package, each child will read the books with their parents, rest comfortably with their blanket, and snuggle closely with their stuffed animal.

## Why We Help...



Every year, hundreds of thousands of American families become homeless. Within these families are more than 1.3 million children, 42% of whom are under the age of 6 years old. (National Coalition for the Homeless)

Homeless children rarely own a teddy bear, a security blanket, or a book. They live on the streets or in shelters without the items of comfort that most American children enjoy nightly. Receiving a good night's sleep is vital for the healthy mental and physical development of any child. Project Night Night is dedicated to creating the most comfortable environment possible for children staying in shelters.

These children endure fear, anxiety, and hunger. Homeless children often witness violence within the family as well as on the streets. "They suffer from dramatically higher levels of acute and chronic illness. They go hungry at twice the rate of other children. As night comes, they wonder where they will sleep." (The National Center on Family Homelessness)
